

# APPLICATION FORM FOR ELLIN GREENE RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

Doctoral students who plan to conduct research about folklore, children's literature and storytelling (youth or adult) through the use of the Ellin Greene Storytelling Collection in the Butler Children's Literature Center are eligible to receive scholarship funds.

1. Complete this application form and include your responses to additional information requested.
2. *All applicants must complete the FAFSA online* at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) (school code: 001750). The FAFSA score must be filed each year the applicant seeks aid and is valid for a one-year period, (July 1 to June 30).
3. Applicants are also required to *submit scores from the GRE or MAT* examination (which is an admission requirement for prospective PhD students).
4. Applicants must plan to enroll in the 2016-2017 academic year.

*If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be responsible for your tuition payment as usual.  
Scholarship monies will be credited to your account after the last day to add/drop courses for that semester.*
